The Nebraska USBC Association has established a scholarship fund to help students to further (his or her) education and training beyond high school in an accredited institution of higher learning.

The Nebraska USBC awards scholarships to be determined by committee but will be for at least \$500.00 each. The number of scholarships awarded each year will be based on the number of applications received and with Nebraska USBC board approval. The scholarship funds are deposited to a SMART account at USBC upon notification to each winner. Once the SMART account receives the funds, they will contact each winner.

Applicant must be a high school senior and a current USBC youth member in good standing and competing in Nebraska certified leagues/events. The applicant must have a minimum 2.5/4.0 GPA or equivalent. An individual can win the award only once.

The application must **include at least one reference** letter but not more than three and **one school transcript. Do not send separately.** Feel free to attach any additional information that supports your application.
