1. Nominee must have a minimum of 5 years of membership in **Nebraska USBC certified leagues and or certified tournaments**.
2. Nominee's record of performance or service should include State and/or local level involvement **certified leagues and/or tournaments**. Since this is a State award, involvement at the State level will be considered an important part of the resume. (I.e. Tournaments, Jamborees, Meetings, etc.)
3. Nominee need not currently be a member or involved in the Nebraska USBC. However, their criteria must be from when they were youth members. Involvement from the collegiate division will be considered only while they held a youth card. Nominee is eligible until they reach the age of 25 years as of August 1st.
4. Only written applications received prior to the deadline will be considered. The committee may ask for additional information or clarification of information submitted.
